A little goes a long way...

\$36 buys a dozen hens — allowing a woman to start a family business in Tanzania or Zambia

Meet Rachel who started raising chickens five years ago. She was able to grow her small flock when she received a gift of a dozen hens in 2009. Later a Global Business Partner provided a small grant that allowed Rachel to buy 200 one-day-old chicks. She now has around 340 chickens. Rachel describes the difference these gifts have made in her life:



“I used to have only two rooms for chickens, now I am filling four rooms full of chickens. I receive more than 100 eggs a day and I sell these in crates of 30 for 4,500 Tanzanian shillings, giving me a profit of around 15,000 shillings a day.”

She also raises ducks, one cow, and two calves, and sells the milk for additional family income.

“I am glad to have a business at home. Some of the extra profit is spent on household expenses. I am paying school fees for my nieces as their mother has passed away and also my own



school fees. I am a student at Open University of Tanzania, I will graduate next year with a Bachelor’s degree in Legal Studies.”

“Thank you for the animal gift and Global Business Partner, they have helped me to improve my business of keeping chickens and now I am earning a stable income of selling eggs and milk!”

\$30 supports a pre-school child in school for three months—helping to pay for school fees, nutrition, and uniforms

Women’s Global Connection’s programs sponsor pre-school children in Mongu, Zambia through the Mothers and Infant Care Program. A similar program in Bukoba, Tanzania benefits three pre-schools by providing breakfast daily to all of the children.

\$50 allows a women entrepreneur to purchase a pig or goat, thereby starting a business to support their family

Women gently care for these precious gifts while working diligently to grow their small businesses.



\$100 cultivates an acre of land in Tanzania or Zambia. Women’s cooperatives plant rice or soy beans

Women from the Masupanzila Women’s Agricultural Society in Mongu Zambia, have successfully grown their rice farm, fully utilizing the two oxen generously donated.



Once the fields are harvested, the products are sold locally and proceeds benefit cooperative members, their families, and the local rural economies.
